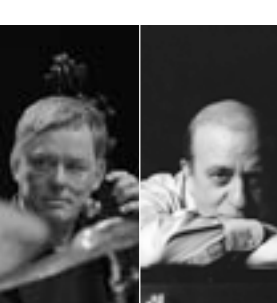


THE SENSATIONAL SWEDISH VOCALIST VIKTORIA TOLSTOY & HER TRIO

THE FRENCH PIANO GENIUS IN RARE CLUB APPEARANCE MARTIAL SOLAL/ MADS VINDING DUO

One of the most prolific and admired jazz musicians to ever come out of France, Martial Solal has solidly established himself as one of the most original and virtuosic jazz pianists of his generation. In 1999 he was awarded the now defunct Jazzpar Prize (often nicknamed "the nobel prize of jazz"). Danish master bassist Mads Vinding has often been a part of Martial Solal's groups and projects and it is a great pleasure to welcome them at Montmartre as a duo for the opening weekend of this first Copenhagen Jazz Festival since the club's re-opening.

As one of the most elegant and mesmerizing jazz pianists of his generation, Kenny Barron's names speaks of itself and barely requires any introduction any longer. He made a unique, powerful and lasting impression on Copenhagen audiences when he recorded the now legendary duo album "People Time" with Stan Getz. The album was Getz' last recording before he died and it was recorded live at the Nørregade-edition of Montmartre in 1991. Since then, Kenny Barron has held a special place in the hearts of jazz fans here. We are thrilled to present the great Kenny Barron for 3 intense nights with his own dynamic group, featuring the acclaimed tenor saxophonist David Sanchez.

ITALIAN VOCAL SENSATION REVISITING ALICE RICCIARDI

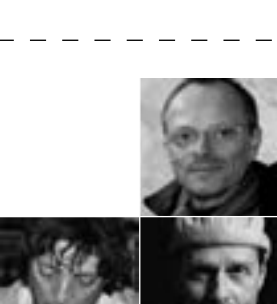

The wonderful Italian jazz singer with the warm and compelling voice, Alice Ricciardi, is back at Montmartre, this time with her own full band from Italy, plus Danish tenor saxophonist Jakob Dinesen as a special guest. Alice Ricciardi started her career in the late 1990s and has since performed at many of the world's most esteemed jazz venues and events, including Jazz at Lincoln Center's «Dizzy's Jazz Club» in New York, The Cotton Club in Tokyo and the Montreux Jazz Festival. Her debut album «Comes Love», released in 2008 on the prestigious Blue Note label, has received critical acclaim, reminding listeners of the elegance and swing found in jazz legends such as Carmen McRae and Nancy Wilson.

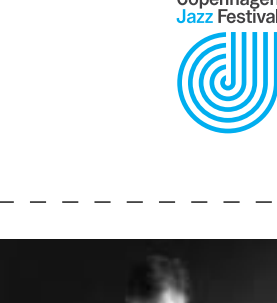
THE REMARKABLE NEW BAND BY NORDSØ, HAACK & BESIÁKOV SMOKERS LOUNGE

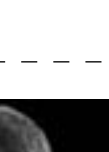

THE GRAMMY* NOMINATED GUITAR INNOVATOR STANLEY JORDAN

American guitar virtuoso Stanley Jordan was the first artist to be signed by Bruce Lundvall when the latter became president of Blue Note Records in 1985 and, consequently, Magic Touch was the first release of the rejuvenated label. Since then, Stanley Jordan has conquered audiences all over the world with his revolutionary approach to the guitar and his unique two-handed tapping technique which earned him several Grammy nominations. He is also deeply involved in the study of music therapy and is a spokesperson for the American Music Therapy Association.
