## THE MONTMARTRE LEGEND RETURNS

### ABDULLAH IBRAHIM TRIO

Today jazz is very international, but it hasn't always been that way. South African pianist Abdullah Ibrahim (formerly known as Dollar Brand), born in Cape Town in 1934, was one of the very first non-American jazz musicians to gain worldwide recognition, when in 1962 he became the protégé of Duke Ellington. With traditional African songs and religious music among his key influences, he introduced a new and distinctly different approach to jazz. He was a regular at the Montmartre in the 1960s and 70s, so it is a great joy to welcome him back for the club's re-opening.

# JAZZHUS Montmartre

## Copenhagen's prime jazz club with world class jazz

Montmartre opened in 1959 and quickly became a magnet for the world's greatest jazz musicians at its famous location on "Store Regnegade 19A" ("Great Rain Street").

Many American jazz stars moved their life and career to Copenhagen and became a part of the special atmosphere and lifestyle around Jazzhus Montmartre until it moved to Nørregade in 1976, where it later closed in 1992.

Stan Getz, Dexter Gordon, Ben Webster, Mercer Ellington, Ed Thigpen, Kenny Drew, Albert "Tootie" Heath, Ernie Wilkins and many more were drawn to Denmark because of Montmartre. Some of them never left, and lived in Copenhagen till the end of their lives.

A whole generation of Danish jazz musicians was educated on the Montmartre stage by the American masters, including the great drummer Alex Riel, the world renowned innovative Danish bass player, the late Niels-Henning Ørsted Pedersen, and many others.

Denmark's legendary jazz club re-opened in May 2010 in its original premises in Copenhagen. The historic re-opening was initiated by the Danish jazz pianist Niels Lan Doky and his friend, media executive and entrepreneur Rune Bech.
